Dear Friend of JCCY,

Since January, it has been a whirlwind of change for Jamie, our children, Allie, Hugh, Luke and me. Speaking at churches every weekend and conducting seminars has confirmed God's calling to serve the larger Body of Christ as an evangelist. There is a recognized need from many pastors and leaders for a clear evangelistic voice to the Church in the islands.

Our radio program *Inspiring Evangelism* is heard by tens of thousands daily and I have spoken to 3,261 people live from the start of 2007.

On Easter Sunday, I asked one of Hawaii's leading pastors about an evangelistic brochure I had given him the previous week. Entitled *Against All Odds*, it includes the story of my 400 fall from Hawaii's Pali Ridge at 18 and how God miraculously saved and called me into service - a compelling way to introduce people to the life changing power of Jesus Christ. The pastor replied, I gave it to an 83 year old woman and she received Christ.

Last week, our Golf Tournament Chairman, Martin Arinaga, saw the evangelistic tract, *Against All Odds*, and said to the committee, *This is why we support JCCY. Tell your friends, this is why they should support JCCY, too; so we can produce resources like these to lead more people to Christ.*

We have trained over 450 people in person representing 28 churches in 8 seminars on doing effective evangelism. Bottom line: more people are engaging in evangelism as a result. Lynn Zurcher of Nanaikapono Protestant Church said, *This seminar removes barriers that prevent many people from sharing their faith.*

Beyond Hawaii, in the next two months we will be doing evangelism overseas in four nations: Dominican Republic, Uganda, Philippines and Brazil. Momentum is building locally and internationally. It is necessary to strategically add staff with key individuals like our new Executive Director, Stephen Lathrop-Lee, who will oversee the operations of JCCY and make it possible for me to be accessible to more people and churches.

To meet growing needs related with evangelism, our operational budget has increased significantly. Our income will need to catch-up. We believe God is guiding us as we step out in faith. We are also taking proper steps to develop the structure necessary to support a growing organization.

This is a special year. We are first, specifically looking for those who will commit to supporting JCCY monthly at any amount the Lord would lead. Second, for those who are already regular donors to consider an increase of some kind. Each gift enables someone's son or daughter, father or mother, sister or brother a chance to know Christ's love personally. Would you pray and ask the Lord how He would have you respond to this opportunity? I realize each donation you give is a sacrifice and comes from your heart. I am grateful for your partnership and hope to hear from you, soon.
